Cora Portal is a configurable, self-service window into your Cora platform — designed to support a variety of use cases and easily tailored to user personas. Whether it's for idea capture, subcontractor input, or partner interaction, it delivers a real-time flow of data in a segmented, secure environment. Portals are intuitive to use, requiring minimal orientation, and allow you to extend access without compromising control or governance.

Streamlined Ideation

The Ideation Portal captures ideas from across your organization, automatically routing them into the Cora platform for review and approval. This improves governance and transparency in business planning by preserving all data through to project creation. It also simplifies New Product Development (NPD) by eliminating manual tools like Microsoft Forms and reducing data reentry — enabling full traceability and easier analysis.

Sub-contractor Management

Easily integrate third-party updates into Cora, with automatic alerts for project managers. Sub-contractors submit documentation via the Portal, which is stored directly in the correct project folder. Documents can be reviewed, approved, or returned with comments — for example, as part of change control. Some customers also use the Portal to capture invoice data, accelerating processing and improving cash flow.

Enhanced Collaboration

Cora customers use Portals to improve collaboration across teams and partners. The simplified interface is ideal for non-PPM users, making it easy to submit updates or upload documents. Interactions follow structured workflows that embed governance and enforce control points. Access is restricted for Portal users, while full platform users retain complete project visibility.

Improved Governance

Cora Portal removes the confusion of email-based collaboration by providing structured workflows and secure access for external stakeholders. Every action is recorded in a full audit trail, supporting transparency, accountability. This reduces risk, simplifies compliance audits, and ensures process integrity across your extended enterprise.


Ideation Portal Use Case

All portals operate within the same Cora instance, enabling centralized review and approval when needed.




Sub-contractor and Partner Use Case

Users can upload documents into structured folders as defined by a Cora administrator.

Permission-controlled access to digitized forms (Registers) allows customers to manage specialized requirements with subcontractors or partners, e.g., Health & Safety, Environmental, or Quality compliance.

Self-Service


